People who lived in a hiding spot and saw jews who needed a place to stay would take them in as if they are their own. One major helper was Johan Van. He was a 75 year old man who saved approximately 600 kids. Not only was he able to save all those kids but he was a survivor and passed away in 2018.



Johan Van was also a dutch teacher. The year Germany invaded the Netherlands he became the principle of the Reformed **Teachers'** Training College in Amsterdam. He helped turn the school into an anti-Nazi sheltor for dutch teachers.

WARRIORS FROM THE HOLOCAUST
